Movies on the Square

Redwood City's Summer movie experience continues with FREE movies on 12 Thursday evenings starting at sundown (approximately 8:45pm). Enjoy classic movies that will delight kids and adults alike through September 9th including *The Blind Side* on July 15th, *UP* on August 9th, and *The Music Man* on September 2nd, among others. Target Family Days will transform Theatre Way, near the corner of Broadway and Middlefield Road, into a walkable assortment of themed family entertainment this summer. Plus, the street will be closed to through traffic, making a stroll along beautiful Theatre Way a fun and relaxing family experience.
